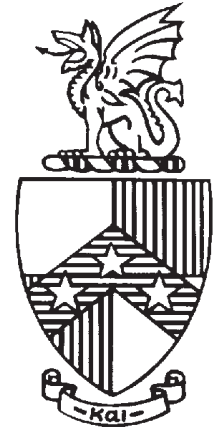


Beta Theta Pi Gamma Eta Chapter Homecoming & Alumni Dinner
